As a state Senator representing Northeast Nebraska, I am writing to express my support for Faith Regional Health Services' (FRHS) pursuit of federal appropriations for Fiscal Year 2010. FRHS is in the middle of a \$10m electronic health record implementation and it would like to extend the benefits of this system to its rural partners in Northeast Nebraska.
